

## Log Cabin Craft

## Materials:

- empty milk carton or juice container,
- brown construction paper (OR stick pretzels)
- scissors
- glue (If you use pretzels, you may want to use store bought frosting to "glue" the pretzels onto the milk carton.)

## Instructions:

It is best if you use the milk or juice containers the children get in the lunchroom you will not need to cut, except to form the roof.

- Make sure container is cleaned and dried well
- Fold the top together then cut the piece that was glued together off and tape the carton together so that it looks like a normal roof.
- Cut strips of brown construction paper same width as the milk carton and about 2 inches in length to make it easier to roll.

(OR use pretzels.)

- Wrap the strips of brown paper around a pencil or straw to form a "log".
- Apply glue to hold together, remove the pencil.
- Glue the logs onto the milk carton walls to make a log cabin.

## **Additional Details**

- Cut out brown construction paper for the roof, yellow for the windows and black for the doors.
- Depending on the age of the children completing the log cabin you can add additional details such as a chimney and landscaping.
